

Short BIO of Dr. Panayiota Petrou, MD

Dr. Petrou Panayiota was born in Limassol, Cyprus, and she completed her Medical Degree at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki Medical School. She completed her specialization in Neurology at Hadassah medical centre in Jerusalem and received the Board Certification in Neurology in Israel and in Greece. Dr. Petrou is working at Hadassah since 2007 and is today a Senior consultant Neurologist at the Multiple sclerosis, Neuroimmunology and cell therapies unit and a senior lecturer in the Hebrew university hospital in Jerusalem. She is actively involved in several research studies and clinical trials in the field of Multiple sclerosis, Neuroimmunology and the use of Stem Cells in neurological diseases and has published numerous papers in leading journals. She has been the co-PI and Clinical Coordinator in the pivotal stem cell trials in MS and Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis completed at Hadassah HMO.

She has served as chairperson in Israel and International meetings and has given several invited lectures in International forums in the field of Neurology and Neuroimmunology.

She is a member of the Israel and Cyprus neurological association and is the treasurer of the Israel Neuroimmunology association.
